Vinha da Palha 2007 Estremadura, Portugal: The second label of Sandra Tavares' Quinta da Chocopalha, this is a blend of 60% Castelao and 40% Tinta Roriz. It's a deliciously bright, fresh red wine with a real Portuguese taste to it: slightly herby ripe plummy fruit with hints of mint and thyme on the nose, leading to a fresh, vibrant palate of ripe cherries and plums, with good acidity and a bit of spicy structure. It's not the world's most complex wine, but it's balanced, food friendly, delicious and relatively inexpensive, it tastes Portuguese, and it delivers just what you want from an everyday wine. 86/100
